The voices or tones played for this program include the sounds of - *English Horn, Tenor Sax, Flugel Horn, Trombone, Oboe, "metal synth", Bassoon, Clarinet, Oboe, Japanese flute (Shakuhachi) and Flute*

Accompaniment tracks use: Grand Piano, Banjo, Harpsichord, Acoustic Bass, Vibraphone, Classical Guitar, English Horn, Pan Flute, Celesta and Music Box

All of these sounds, are produced by a MIDI tone generator and synthesizer (Ketron SD4) that has over 500 available voices.

The accompaniments sequences were created using music editing software on a laptop computer.


The Most Asked Questions.

1) What is that thing you're playing?

The "Wind Shaper" is a Wind MIDI* Controller. It does the same thing for a wind instrument player that a keyboard does for a pianist, sending MIDI codes to a sound generator.

2) Who's playing the accompaniment?

The accompaniment for my performances was created on and is played by my laptop computer. Like a keyboard, the computer sends a sequence of MIDI codes to the sound generator.
